

DANIJEL DETONI – piano

Danijel Detoni began his musical education in Zagreb in the class of Olga Detiček at the Vatroslav Lisinski Music School, and continued in the classes of László Baranyay and Balázs Kecskés at the Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music in Budapest, as well as with Itamar Golan at the Conservatoire in Paris.

He also gained knowledge through working with renowned artists such as Pnina Salzman, Emanuel Krasovsky, Hamsa al-Wadi, Felix Gottlieb, Pál Éder, and Dénes Várjon.

As a soloist and chamber musician, he has performed at prestigious festivals such as the Warsaw Autumn, Music Biennale Zagreb, Musica Danubiana in Ljubljana, Dubrovnik Summer Festival, Osor Musical Evenings, Julian Rachlin & Friends, Transeuropéenes in Rouen, Schleswig-Holstein in Hamburg, ReMusica in Pristina, Carniarmonie in Udine, and Trieste Prima in Trieste.

He has collaborated with artists such as Katarina Livljanić (as a member of the Dialogos ensemble), Radovan Vlatković, Ivana Lazar, Kajana Pačko, Boris Brovtsyn, Itamar Golan, Gábor Boldoczki, Krešimir Stražanac, Irvin Venyš, Boris Andrianov, David Aaron Carpenter, Enrico Dindo, as well as ensembles such as the Zagreb Saxophone Quartet, Budapest Strings, UMZE Chamber Orchestra, Dušan Skovran Chamber Orchestra, among others.

He has been a passionate chamber musician since his early days: in April 2003, he won the Leó Weiner National Competition in Budapest in a duo with violinist Márta Deák, and in August 2006, he received the Israeli Isman Foundation Award for outstanding interpretation of Ligeti's music. In 2008, the Croatian Musical Youth named him the best young musician of the year. That same year, he released a solo album with selected works by Dubravko Detoni under the Croatia Records label. In 2014, the same label released the album *Journey through Europe*, and in 2018, the Belgian label Le Chant de Linos released an album in collaboration with cellist Kajana Pačko.

Since 2009, he has been teaching piano, and since 2015, both piano and chamber music at the Music Academy of the University of Zagreb.
